Ofsted Inspection As you are all aware, we had a visit from the Ofsted inspectors this week for two days. Although we have to wait for 30 working days before we receive the outcome, I just wanted to say a huge thank you to you all for your support and very kind words both personally and through the questionnaire. I’d also like to thank our incredible staff who remained calm and positive throughout the very rigorous inspection process. Our children were fantastic as always and the inspectors were very impressed by their excellent manners and the friendly welcome they gave them. I will notify you once the report is published which will probably be in May.

Covid Restrictions Following the Secretary of State’s latest steps for ‘Living with Covid’, the DFE has issued the following guidance:

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature, should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and are well enough to attend.

Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.

Easter Bingo Thursday 7th April. Tickets will be on sale in the playground or from the school office after school on the 4th, 5th and 6th April, or you can buy them on the door. Two tickets for each of the 5 games will be £3 or four tickets £4. A drink and snack will be included in the ticket price for the children and other refreshments will be available to purchase.
