School Meals Update

The ongoing rise in food and staffing costs is impacting schools and businesses across the country. Sadly Fresha, have informed us of a price rise to school meals to ensure they are able to meet their own cost increases. Therefore, from the summer term – beginning **Tuesday 22nd April, the cost per meal will increase to £2.70 per meal for all paid meals.**



Children eligible for pupil premium and all children in EYFS and Year 1 and 2 will continue to receive free meals.

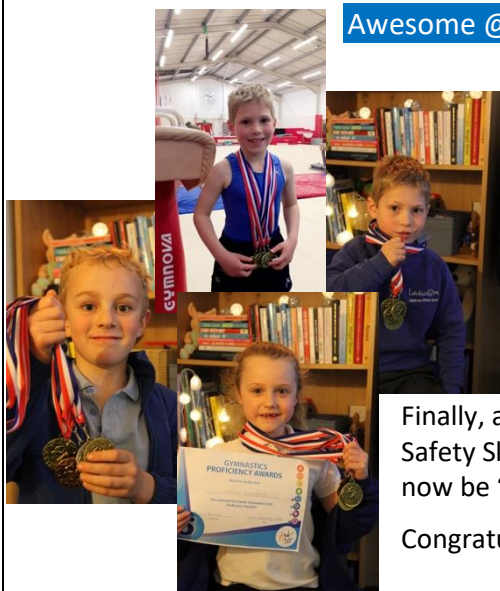


Awesome @ Landscore
