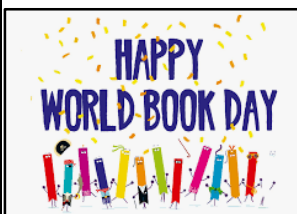
Outdoor Classroom

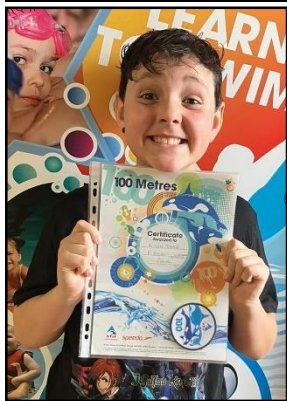

Dangerous Parking Unfortunately, we have seen an increase in the numbers of cars parking dangerously after school when our children and families are trying to safely walk home.
