<u>Children's Mental Health Week</u> Next week is Children's Mental Health Week. This national week is an opportunity to shine a spotlight on the importance of children's mental health and wellbeing. This year's theme is 'My Voice Matters' which is about providing children with the tools they need to express themselves. Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes, and to have their views considered and taken seriously.



When we feel empowered, there's a positive impact on our wellbeing. Children who feel that their voices are heard and can make a difference have a greater sense of community and self-esteem.

<u>Children's Books</u> Children in Years 1-6 will be bringing home a folder today containing their English and Maths books along with a short termly report. This is in preparation for parent's evenings next week. I hope you enjoy looking through your child's work with them over the weekend but please remember to return ALL books to school on Monday morning. Many thanks. As you look through the books, you may notice that we don't write many comments on children's work as we focus much more on 'live' marking and immediate feedback. Teachers are constantly checking in with children and giving feedback during the sessions which helps them to make improvements before the end of a lesson (if you see 'VF' written on a piece of work, you know verbal feedback was given).

You may also see highlighters being used in the sustained writing books (the purple books). We use 'pink to think' and 'awesome orange' and the children have to identify what needs to improve or what the teacher was impressed with, so the numbers at the end of the writing allow the child to reflect and identify these elements.
