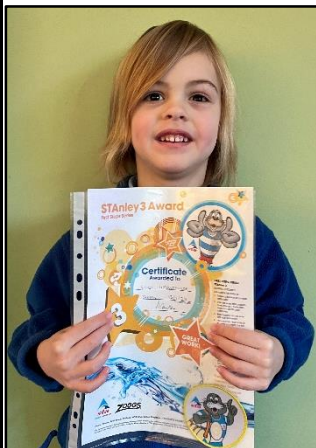
Term Dates 2024-25 These are the term dates for the next academic year, starting from September 2024. Green squares show the days when children are not in school.

The app is popular for viral dances and celebrity cameos and is a creative and fun platform for teens to enjoy. The minimum age for having a TikTok account is 13 according to TikTok's terms and conditions. Many parents have expressed concerns about the inappropriate language and content of some of the videos posted which is what makes this app unsuitable for younger children.
