Rugby Taster Session for Year 3 Children

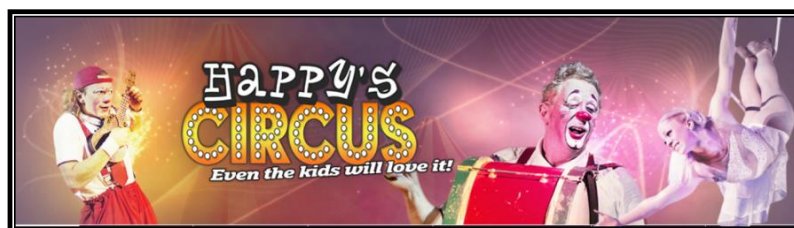

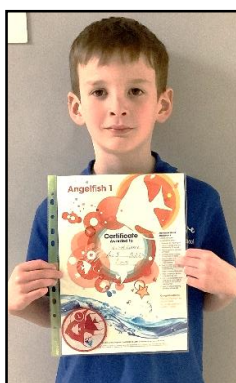
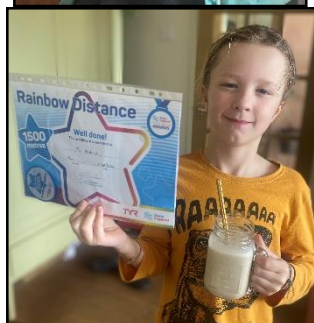

Recorder group lessons: There will be 4 groups, by age: reception, year 1, year 2 and KS2.

Children will need to have a recorder for lessons, and yr 2 upwards will need a simple folder for music sheets. Cost of recorder lessons this term: £36.60

DooD group lessons for KS2 children. The DooD is designed as a starter instrument for the clarinet and saxophone. It is a small instrument similar in size to a recorder. Children need to have their own DooD (although the school does have a few DooDs that can be used in lessons). For new starters, children will need to have a (free) try out on the DooD, to get an idea of the instrument (particularly how to blow), so that they can join the group.
