School Meals Reminder

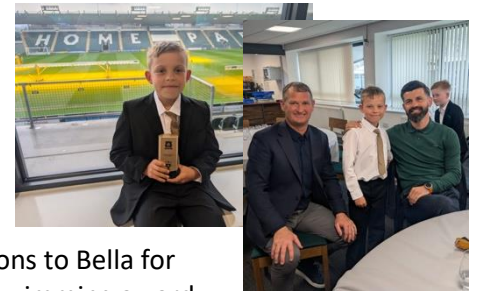
Please remember the price for hot meals increases from the beginning of the summer term, **Tuesday 22nd April**, and the cost per meal will increase to **£2.70 per meal**.
