After School Parental Supervision As the weather improves, it is always lovely to see more families staying in our playground to use the facilities after school. Unfortunately though, the behaviour of some children at this time is causing both myself and our neighbours some concern. I have received reports of children urinating behind the bushes on the field, climbing trees and using the play equipment dangerously. All children know the rules in school and I would expect them to follow the same rules at the end of the school day. Please ensure that you maintain full supervision of your child when they are playing around the field and continue to reinforce the school rules. Please also be aware of our after school clubs and KSC children and ensure that your child does not play in the areas that these groups are using.

**Bike Safety** It has also been great to see more children riding their bikes to school since the weather has started to improve but I have received a number of reports from people who are concerned about the safety of some children when riding their bikes. A number of children have

not been wearing helmets and have also been riding dangerously in and out of parked cars. Please talk to your child about road safety, especially if they are riding their bike to school.
