At Landscape, we regard ourselves as a warm and welcoming school which has high expectations of both ourselves and our pupils. We pride ourselves on being a happy, open and inclusive school where individuals are respected and collaboration valued. We are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic and dedicated full time teacher who will fully support and contribute to the school's ethos and further development.

The School

Landscape Primary School is a local authority maintained primary school in mid Devon. It is situated in the friendly town of Crediton which is 7 miles north west of Exeter.

The school has 13 modern, well equipped classrooms plus a library, music room, art room and a large all purpose assembly hall, which is fully equipped with stage lights and an excellent sound system. Our ICT provision is very good with a range of ipads and tablets available for all children. Every class has an interactive whiteboard and projector. There are two hard play areas and a large playing field surrounded by trees and banks of shrubs. In addition there is a garden and animal area, plus a woodland area with a fire-pit and den-making resources. We also have a school dog who comes in for two days a week.

This part-time position is for 28 hours a week. The successful candidate will work closely with the EYFS teacher but will be responsible for their own 'class' of 6 EYFS children.
