At Landscore, we regard ourselves as a warm and welcoming school which has high expectations of both ourselves and our pupils. We pride ourselves on being a happy, open and inclusive school where individuals are respected and collaboration valued. We are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic and dedicated class teacher who will fully support and contribute to the school's ethos and further development.

The School

Landscore Primary School is a local authority maintained primary school in mid Devon. It is situated in the friendly town of Crediton which is 7 miles North West of Exeter.

The school has 13 modern, well equipped classrooms plus a library, music room, art room and a large all purpose assembly hall, which is fully equipped with stage lights and sound system. There are two hard play areas and a large playing field surrounded by trees and banks of shrubs. In addition there is a garden and animal area with chickens, rabbits and guinea-pigs, and a woodland area with a fire-pit and den-making resources. We also have a school dog who is in school for two days a week.

Details of the post:

One of the positions will be full time in a Year 3/4 class starting in September 2024. The other post is for 3 days a week, in a KS1 class, starting in November. The teachers in the both teams are highly experienced so you would be ably supported by colleagues for planning and assessment.
