

Lesson 9: Mummification – non-fiction writing


Today we are researching and learning about the process of mummification.

Tip: Think back to all the instructions you have written previously in Years two, three, four and five.

Activity: to write a set of instructions

Title: 'How to mummify an Egyptian Pharaoh'.

Your instructions will contain:-



- An opening paragraph
- You will need/equipment list
- Technical vocabulary
- The actual steps to mummify, numbered and in order
- Sentences starting with: Imperative (bossy) verbs for example: Place, Cut, Remove, etc.; time adverbials such as: First..., Next..., After you have..., etc. and subordinate clauses like: When you have removed the heart, ...; If the chest cavity starts to collapse, ..., etc.
- Labelled diagrams to assist the reader with the instructions
- A closing paragraph
