Lower KS2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn and revise new vocabulary, developing understanding • To show understanding of grammar points e.g. preparing in pairs and explaining to new pupils • To show increasing confidence and complexity when revisiting vocabulary e.g. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - adding conjunctions, adverbs and adjectives where appropriate - taking a lead in asking as well as answering questions - paying attention to pronunciation and intonation - becoming more confident with the written form
Upper KS2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To use more complex language in spoken and written work e.g. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - working at sentence level rather than word/phrase level - using full question and answer sequences - using adjectives and conjunctions to lengthen phrases • To demonstrate extra confidence through more independent use of vocabulary, grammar and language learning skills • To show greater understanding of revisited skills e.g. pronunciation, grammar points
